- One year of previous youth ministry experience (preferred but not required).
- A calling to use one's discipleship and leadership abilities in service to a local church.
- Have a good understanding of the challenges and needs facing youth today.
- Good computer skills and proficiency with social media.
- Good organizational & communication skills (verbal and written).
- A strong desire to see youth thrive in relationship with God and their parents.
- The ability to lead by example.

MINISTRY POSITION OVERVIEW

The Youth Leader is responsible for providing leadership for all components of the youth ministry at Church on the Rock.

Those responsibilities include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Participate in staff meetings as requested.
- Oversee, coordinate, and facilitate the growth of the youth ministry.
- Design or evaluate curriculum for youth programs, events, and classes.
- Model and lead students in the pursuit of spiritual growth and Christ likeness.
- Embrace, adhere to, and help refine church accountability measures to help guard and maintain healthy physical and emotional boundaries with our youth.
- Work with and maintain an active team of youth lay leaders.
- Seek opportunities to Interact with students during the week and at church.
- Work to develop supportive relationships with the parents of our youth.
- Develop and manage a youth ministry budget.
- Work to assimilate all youth into the life of the church considering language, cultural, and social differences.

- Share in the planning, promotion, and execution of Church on the Rock's mission.
- Participate in a Life Group at Church on the Rock.
- Other ministries/duties as needed by the church and assigned by the Pastor.

COMPENSATION, HOURS, & BENEFITS

- Salary: Salary offers will be based on the experience and ability of the candidate.
- **Theological Education Aid:** The church will seek to provide financial aid in support of approved theological education.
